



## 2013 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

*Napa Valley*

### VINEYARD

Our 2013 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is composed of grapes from a gravely vineyard located in Yountville in the west side of the Napa Valley. 2013 was a bountiful harvest and will be remembered as an exceptional vintage in the Napa Valley. Weather conditions were warm and moderate; not too hot, not too cold. These weather conditions benefited color and tannin development.

### WINEMAKING

In 2013, the hallmark of the vintage is the strong tannin structure which indicates great cellaring potential of this wine. We fermented these grapes for three weeks at warm temperatures and followed with extended maceration, extracting maximum ripe flavors and supple tannins. The wine was aged in 50% new and 50% older French Oak barrels for twenty months. The wine was bottled in July, 2015.

### TASTING NOTES

Fragrances of cassis, anise and dark fruits. Ripe blackberry flavors with smooth acidity to create a long velvety finish. Medium tannin structure that flows to slight clove and cinnamon spices with plum acidity. Our 2013 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon has a great deal of finesse, and we can expect it to be at its peak from 2016 through 2026.
